Program Abstract

This program is for all clinicians and managers who perform, audit and/or are responsible for integrity of OASIS-D1 in a home health agency. Beginners to OASIS-D1, those who are struggling with OASIS-D1, or those who need a refresher will all benefit from this seminar.

The first hour will be spent on the very basics. Starting with the CMS concept behind OASIS-D1 and how it ties to the comprehensive assessment, we will then go over the OASIS-D1 Data Set and review the OASIS conventions. Finally, we will show examples of intent and guidance in the OASIS manual, chapter 3.

We will then discuss how to perform a comprehensive OASIS assessment with your patient. This is key to the integrity of the patient and your agency's outcomes as well as determining the functional impairment level for PDGM. All clinicians have to do the assessment consistently in this manner for all OASIS timepoints, including Discharge. So don't miss this crucial segment!

The intent that CMS has behind every OASIS item is very important to understand in order to assign the correct scores for your patients. Many clinicians do not know the intent or how to apply it to their patients. We will outline the rationale and the intent of M/GG/J items as well as review in detail the M items used to determine the Functional Impairment Level in PDGM.

Finally, we will review scenarios and discuss rationales to demonstrate how to correctly score OASIS items.
